System for Award Management (SAM): <https://www.sam.gov>. SAM is the gateway to Government contracts. It is **MANDATORY** for all companies to be registered in SAM before they can receive a Government contract award. During the registration process you will be assigned a CAGE Code and UEI Code unique to your company. If you need assistance with registration, contact your local Procurement Technical Assistance Center (PTAC) (<http://www.aptac-us.org/>) and they can help with the process.

Procurement Integrated Enterprise Environment (PIEE): <https://piee.eb.mil/>. PIEE is the primary enterprise, procure-to-pay (P2P) application for the DoD and its supporting agencies.

SBA provides assistance to small businesses on how to get started, contracting support, and understanding the Federal market place.
