


# Eglin Regional Hospital, 96<sup>th</sup> MDG Hospital Realignment Project

## PROJECT OVERVIEW:

- A 23,359 GSF Annex for AMDS, Flight Medicine, Public Health, and TOPA will create space in the hospital for expansion and realignment of patient care functions.
- Administration functions (Command Section and Information Management) will move from the hospital to Buildings 2794 and 2795.
- Renovation of the hospital will realign and better accommodate patient care functions.
- The two existing East entries will be upgraded to improve energy performance, aesthetics, way finding, and safety.
- The Southeast entry will serve the Emergency Department, Surgical Suite, and Inpatient Units.
- The Northeast entry will serve the Specialty Clinics and Diagnostic and Treatment Functions (Pharmacy, Lab, and Diagnostics Imaging).
- An addition will be constructed at the Northeast end of the Surgical Suite to accommodate the new hybrid and neurological operating rooms.
- An addition will be constructed on the west and south sides of the existing Emergency Department area to accommodate Physical Medicine.

The Eglin Regional Hospital is underway on a major renovation and addition project. On April 1<sup>st</sup>, JE Dunn Construction + HWA Architects arrived on the medical campus and construction began on May 16<sup>th</sup>. Throughout the course of the project 37 moves will occur in the main facility and on the overall medical campus. The construction duration is scheduled for 36 months with a overall completion date of December 2014.

The Medical Group project team will be working closely with the department heads and JE Dunn on construction phasing, temporary moves, and construction to ensure that the hospital remains fully operational throughout the duration of the project. Each move will be carefully communicated with staff, departments, and patrons through message boards, meetings, e-mails, and digital medium.

Once complete, the 145,000 SF renovation and addition will result in a state of the art hospital and medical treatment facility to serve the needs of the 96<sup>th</sup> Medical Group. A complete redesign of the site and the facility will provide a campus-like environment. Departmental zoning, improved space adjacencies, and technological advancements will create an efficient environment.

Designed to create a natural healing environment, landscaped courtyards and walkways will connect the interior and exterior. Bright, open, and airy will be the interior feel with improved materials, furnishings and patient and staff amenities. A variety of ceiling heights and roof lines add texture and style to facilities.
