8 9 10 11 12	Interested parties are hereby notified that the U.S. Department of the Air Force, Eglin Air Force Base (AFB), Florida announces the availability of the Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Proposed Beddown of an F-35A Developmental Testing (DT) Program at Eglin AFB, Florida, and Draft Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for a 30-day public review and comment period.
13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21	The EA analyzes potential environmental impacts from construction and operation activities required to support the F-35A DT mission including: construction of a 2-bay aircraft maintenance hangar and aircraft parking area, construction of a 2-bay aircraft test hangar, an addition to Building 64, demolition of Building 965 and relocation of the Maritime Operations Group and boat storage functions to an area away from the airfield, and renovation of four existing support facilities; beddown and operation of four F-35A DT aircraft and an additional maximum of 270 personnel and their dependents; airfield operations at Eglin AFB and Tyndall AFB; and weapons DT operations including defensive countermeasures and munitions expenditures over land and water ranges.
